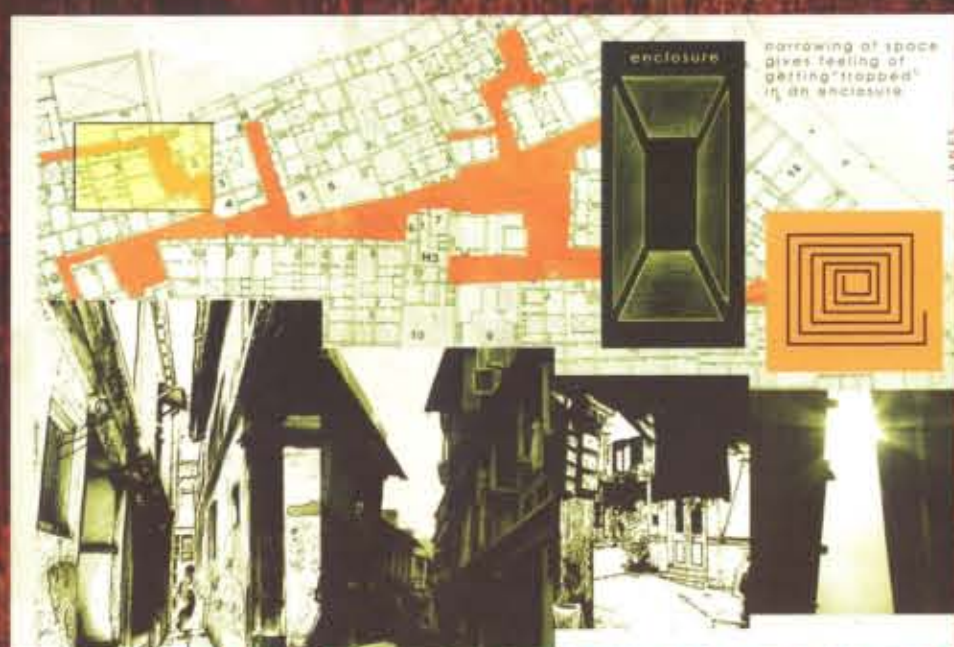
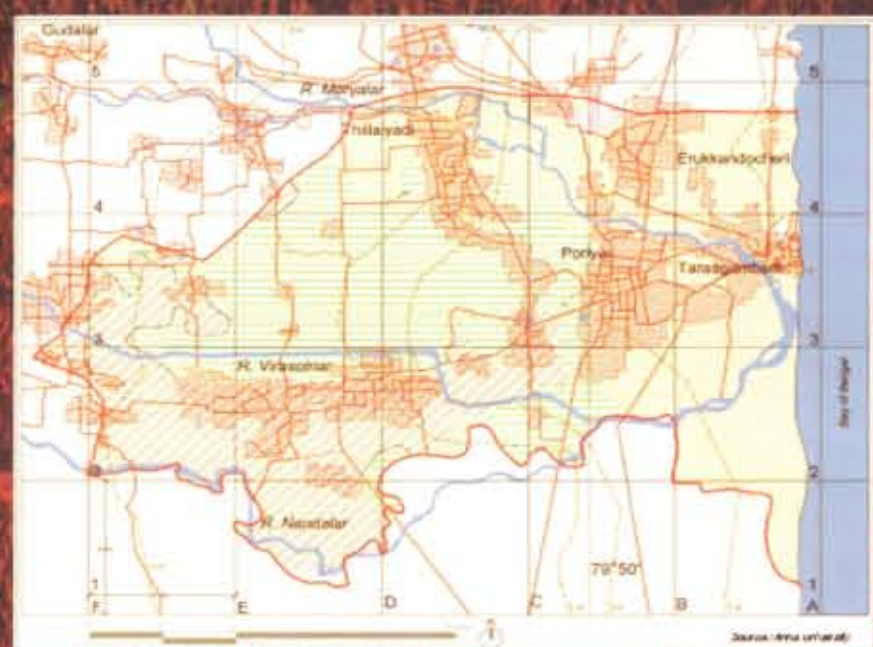

THEORY OF LANDSCAPE

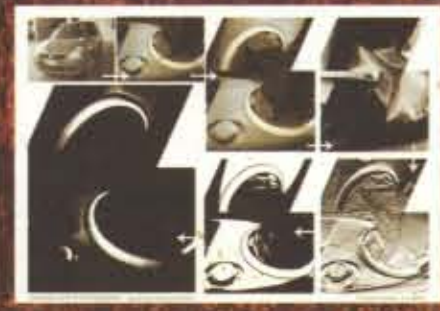
Theory and history have always been synonymous. But, we have never tried to justify the reasons for evaluating the systems in consonance.

THE PROGRAM

Faculty of Architecture, offers a four semester Masters program in Landscape Architecture. It imparts education in Plant and Environmental sciences, Environmental planning, Environmental law, Design theory, Landscape engineering and Project management. This knowledge is explored, tested and refined in a range of studio projects, which form the core of the program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Bachelors Degree in Architecture or equivalent, as recognized by the competent authority. Minimum requirement, 50% aggregate in Undergraduate program, with atleast 60% in the final year project/thesis. Two years experience in profession and/or teaching, after graduation is desirable. Selection shall be done by the Admission Committee of the CEPT University, and shall consist of evaluation of design portfolio, written examination, group discussion and personal interview. Students awaiting final examination results can also apply. However their admission shall be on provisional basis and they must submit the final mark sheet and migration certificate before Friday 31st October 2008.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

For application forms and details, please contact, The Chairman, Admission Committee(Landscape Architecture Program), CEPT University, Navrangpura, Ahmedabad-380009. Application form and letters of recommendation (2 nos.) should be accompanied by a DD of Rs.500/- drawn on a nationalized bank in favour of "School of Architecture", payable at Ahmedabad. The form can also be downloaded from the website www.cept.ac.in. Completed forms with the recommendation letters in sealed envelopes, copies of the marksheets, a design portfolio(only selected work in A4 size) with a DD as mentioned above to be sent as per the details indicated. GATE SCHOLARSHIP / STIPEND / FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) qualified candidates are eligible for stipend as per AICTE norms, if sanctioned by AICTE. The GATE scholarship is presently Rs.5000/- per month.
